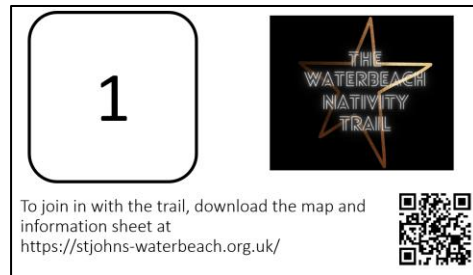


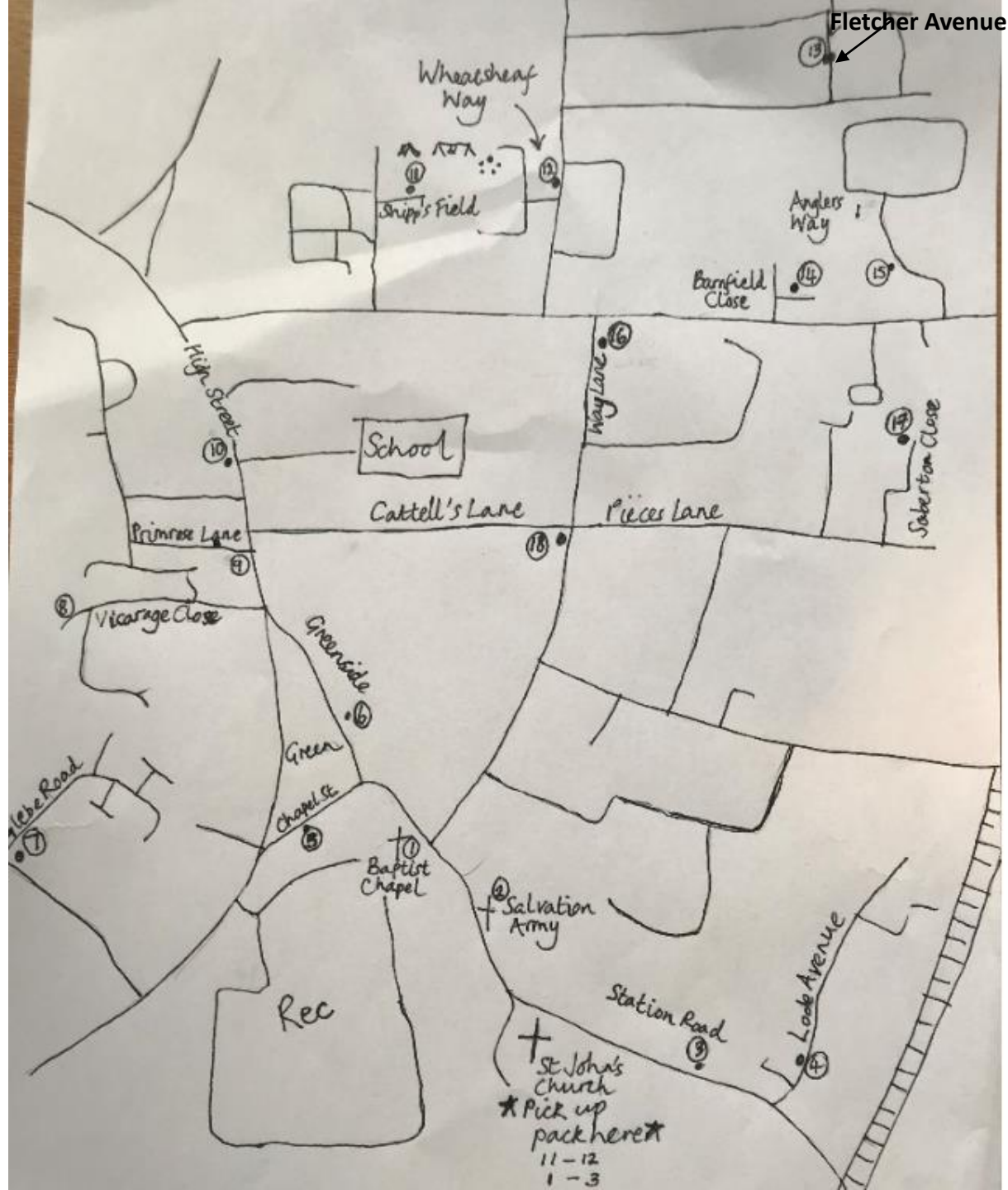


The trail will run from 11am -3pm on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> December.

- The trail can be completed in any order, and you can do as much or as little of it as you like!
- Find each location (or as many as you are able!) on the map. The number on the map corresponds with the trail number; you need to find which house is the correct one on the given road. Locations shown are at approximately the correct point along the road given! Each location will have a part of the Christmas story, or a nativity scene, somewhere in a window or outside the house. It will have a sign like this up:



- Decide which letter on the 'Parts of the Story' grid this location number corresponds with, and write the number in the box next to it.
- Please note that there will be a station at the Salvation Army and at the Baptist Chapel!
- Finally, pick up your Christmas craft pack from outside St John's church! These will be available between 11am-12pm and 1pm-3pm.

B	<b>An Angel visits Mary.</b> Mary is told that she will give birth to a Saviour , and is to call him Jesus.	
C	<b>Caesar Augustus calls a census.</b> Mary and Joseph must travel to Bethlehem, a town 90 miles away, to be counted.	
D	<b>The journey.</b> Mary and Joseph travel to Bethlehem on a donkey.	
E	<b>No room at the inn!</b> The town is busy, and there is no room for Mary and Joseph.	
F	<b>Shepherds on a hillside</b> watch their sheep.	
G	<b>The shepherds see a bright light.</b> Angels tell them to journey to Bethlehem, where a Saviour has been born.	
H	<b>Jesus is born.</b> His mother wraps him in swaddling clothes and lays him in a manger.

I	<b>Wise men from the East see a star.</b>	
J	<b>The wise men journey to Bethlehem</b> to find the Saviour who has been born.	
K	<b>The wise men visit Herod</b> to find out where the Saviour has been born. However, they are warned in a dream not to return to Herod.	
L	<b>The wise men see Jesus!</b> They kneel down and give him gifts of Gold, frankincense and myrrh.	
M	<b>A star shines</b> above the stable where Jesus is born.	
N	<b>Jesus, Light of the World,</b> is with us now!	
O P Q	<b>These are all Nativity scenes!</b>
