St John's Updated Covid Guidelines

The CofE recommends that we should continue to be careful given the current rate of infections. St John's PCC and Churchwardens have decided to follow this advice and keep to a cautious approach for the moment.

Here's what we will do from now:

- We will no longer use the booking system for services; instead please use the NHS app (if you have a smartphone) to check in, otherwise the stewards will ask you to note your contact information; this is still needed for "test and trace"
- Please wear face coverings in Church; "the government expects and recommends that people wear face coverings in crowded and enclosed settings to protect themselves and others" (from CofE guidance notes)
- We will sing but keeping face coverings on
- We are keeping the arrangement of alternate pews for now
- We will receive Holy Communion (just the wafer) at our seats
- Please continue to "distance" while entering and leaving

Once seated in Church, please don't move about and please stay in place for the peace

We've been serving refreshments after services these last few weeks - and that will continue!

All Saints' Updated Covid Guidelines

- We will no longer use the booking system for services
- Please continue to wear masks in church
- Singing will take place outside the church
- We will continue to sit in alternate pews
- Social distancing will be maintained in church and outside
- We will have wafers only for Communion
- The chancel will be sanitised and opened daily.

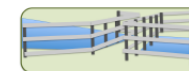
Footsteps
