


- The trail can be completed in any order, and you can do as much or as little of it as you like!

Locations shown are at approximately the correct point along the road given! Each location will have a part of the Christmas story somewhere in a window or outside the house. It will have a sign like this up:



- Decide which letter on the 'Parts of the Story' grid this location number corresponds with, and write the number in the box next to it.
- The **Baptist Church** will be open all day for their **Christmas Café**, serving seasonal refreshments and displaying a crib scene.
- **St Johns Church** will be open, with a display of crib scenes and a craft pack for all those taking part in the trail! At 4pm, there will be a short **Christingle service**- all are welcome!
- **The Salvation Army Church** will have a Nativity display outside.

B	<b>An Angel visits Mary.</b> Mary is told that she will give birth to a Saviour , and is to call him Jesus.	
C	<b>Caesar Augustus calls a census.</b> Mary and Joseph must travel to Bethlehem, a town 90 miles away, to be counted.	
D	<b>The journey.</b> Mary and Joseph travel to Bethlehem on a donkey.	
E	<b>No room at the inn!</b> The town in busy, and there is no room for Mary and Joseph.	
F	<b>Shepherds on a hillside</b> watch their sheep. The see a bright light.

G	<b>Angels tell the shepherds to journey to Bethlehem, where a Saviour has been born.</b>	
H	<b>Jesus is born.</b> His mother wraps him in swaddling clothes and lays him in a manger.	
I	<b>Wise men from the East see a star.</b>	
J	<b>The wise men journey to Bethlehem</b> to find the Saviour who has been born.	
K	<b>The wise men see Jesus!</b> They kneel down and give him gifts of Gold, frankincense and myrrh.	
L,M,N	<b>A star shines</b> above the stable where Jesus is born.
